Aqualis Offshore is committed to prevention of all types of accidents, protecting people, the environment and customer property and conducting its business legitimately, ethically and in a socially responsible manner.

We will implement the following objectives into all decisions affecting our operations:

Regulatory Compliance: We will ensure that all applicable legal, regulatory and contractual requirements are met and adopt sound professional judgment where regulatory requirements do not exist.

Occupational Health & Safety: Occupational health and safety values will not be compromised. No job is so important and no task so urgent that the necessary steps cannot be taken to perform it safely.
